

**Instructions:**

Step 1: Choose which set of “Pronouns” (if any) to print out (colored vs. not colored)  
Step 2: Cut out “Pronouns” pocket and mount to file folder to hold playing pieces.

**Playing:**

Version 1: Using the colored pieces, match put the pronouns in order.

Version 2: Using the pieces that have not been colored, sort by pronoun type and put in order.

Version 3: Laminiate the background sheet and use a dry erase marker to write in the pronouns.
