



WHAT'S HAPPENING AT THIS POINT IN GOD'S STORY?

Yesterday, we talked about how God spoke to create everything he made, and then used dirt from the ground and his own breath to make people. Today, we're talking about those first two people – Adam and Eve. We know that God put them in a beautiful garden and that they were able to walk and talk with God and they could eat anything they wanted to . . . except for the fruit from one tree in the Garden. God had told them not to eat from that one tree.

BIBLE READING

Genesis 3:1-7, Genesis 3:13-15 and Genesis 3: 22-24

WHAT DO THOSE VERSES TELL US ABOUT GOD?

Adam and Eve didn't get to live very long in the garden God made for them before they disobeyed him. We usually hear this part of the God's story called "The Fall," and it's really a sad part of the story. It's because of The Fall that we all live in a world where people continue to make bad choices and have to deal with sin and sickness and death. It's an important reminder for us that making bad choices doesn't just affect the person who makes the choice.

The HAPPY part of God's story today is that God had a plan even from then to bring us back to him! When he tells the snake that the woman's offspring will strike his head, we believe that He talking about Jesus! God already knew, from the very beginning, that He would send His Son to save us!
