String Instruments

- 1. Color the <u>neck</u> of each instrument green.
- 2. Color the *tuning pegs* of each instrument red
- 3. Often, string instruments are played with a **bow**. Color the **bow blue**.
- 4. The **body** of string instruments are usually made from wood. Color the **body brown**.

Woodwind Instruments


- 1. Circle the **mouthpiece** of each instrument.
- 2. If an instrument is played by blowing across a <u>reed</u>, color the circle you just drew <u>yellow</u>.
- 3. If an instrument has a **whistle-type mouthpiece**, color the circle you drew **blue**.
- 4. The bodies of woodwind instruments are all basically pipes with holes. Color the "pipe" whatever color you like.

Brass Instruments

- Brass instruments are long pipes (often curved or curled) with wide openings at the ends, called <u>bells</u>.
 Draw a square around the <u>bells</u> of these instruments.
- 2. Brass instruments are played by buzzing your lips against the **mouthpiece**. Color the **mouthpieces** red.
- <u>Valves</u> open and close different parts of the pipe when you press on them to create different notes. Color the <u>valves</u> blue.
- 4. The **body** of brass instruments are usually made from
